Located in eastern Rwanda near the Tanzania border, we travel early in the morning to **Akagera National Park** where lions wake with the rising sun, giraffes watch golden light kiss the savannas, and the wetlands whisper stories only nature can tell. What You'll See and Experience in Akagera:

- **Big Five Game Drives**: Spot lions, elephants, buffalos, leopards, and rhinos roaming freely across the savannah
- Other Wildlife: See giraffes, zebras, hippos, crocodiles, antelope, warthogs, and more
- **Boat Safaris**: Cruise on **Lake Ihema**, where you can get up close to hippos, crocodiles, and water birds
- **Birdwatching Paradise**: With over **500 bird species**, including the rare shoebill stork, Akagera is a top spot for bird lovers
- **Beautiful Landscapes**: Rolling hills, open plains, papyrus swamps, and lake shores—perfect for photography
- Night Game Drives: A chance to see nocturnal animals like hyenas, civets, and bush babies
- Local Conservation Story: Learn how Akagera was restored from near-collapse to a thriving wildlife sanctuary thanks to conservation efforts

The hands-on elements and live performances make it feel less like a static exhibition and more like a living cultural journey.

DAY 6:Nyungwe Forest & Golden Monkey Trekking

Step Into the Wild ***



Located in southwestern Rwanda, Nyungwe Forest National Park is a lush, misty rainforest filled with incredible biodiversity and adventure. It's one of Africa's oldest rainforests, untouched for thousands of years, and a paradise for nature lovers.

What You'll See and Experience in Nyungwe:

- Chimpanzee Trekking: Track wild chimpanzees as they swing through the trees and call to each other—an exciting, up-close encounter with our closest relatives
- Canopy Walkway: Walk across a 70-meter-high suspended bridge, offering bird's-eye views of the forest canopy and dramatic valleys below
- 13 Primate Species: Spot colobus monkeys, L'Hoest's monkeys, and baboons—Nyungwe is home to the largest variety of primates in East Africa
- Over 300 Bird Species: Perfect for birdwatchers—look out for rare and colorful species like the Rwenzori turaco and great blue turaco
- Waterfalls and Trails: Hike through scenic forest trails to hidden waterfalls like Isumo Waterfall
- Orchids and Ferns: Discover over 1,000 plant species, including beautiful wild orchids
- Peace and Fresh Air: It's a calm, cool environment—ideal for relaxation and reconnecting with nature

We drive through the forest and stop in Kibuye for a night

Overnight: Kibuye lake kivu

Meals: Breakfast

DAY7: RUBAVU LAKE KIVU

Located along Rwanda's western border with the DRC, **Lake Kivu** is a beautiful freshwater lake surrounded by rolling hills, lush greenery, and charming towns like **Gisenyi**, **Kibuye**, and **Rusizi**. It's the perfect place to unwind after gorilla trekking or volcano hikes.

What You'll See and Do at Lake Kivu:

- **Stunning Views**: Calm blue waters, islands, and dramatic hills—perfect for photography and sunset lovers
- Beaches: Enjoy sandy shores in Gisenyi where you can swim or sunbathe (no hippos or crocodiles here!)
- Boat Rides: Take a scenic boat trip to lake's Islands, or explore local fishing villages
- Hot Springs: Visit the Nyamyumba Hot Springs and hear local legends while soaking your feet
- Water Sports: Go kayaking, paddleboarding, or take a relaxing cruise
- Cultural Encounters: Meet local fishermen, explore markets, and learn about lakeside life

Whether you want adventure or just peace and quiet, Lake Kivu offers a beautiful balance of both

Evening we travel 1H30 min to musanze

- Stopover at a tea plantation for a cultural experience
- Check-in at lodge near Volcanoes National Park

DAY 8/9: Gorilla Trekking in Volcanoes National Park

One of the most unforgettable experiences in Rwanda is a **mountain gorilla trek** in **Volcanoes National Park**, located in the northwest near Musanze. This lush, misty rainforest is home to over a third of the world's remaining mountain gorillas.

With expert guides and trackers, you'll hike through beautiful terrain—bamboo forests, volcanic hills, and jungle trails—until you come face-to-face with a gorilla family in their natural habitat. Watching them feed, play, and care for their young just a few meters away is truly magical and humbling.

But the adventure doesn't stop there:

- Spot golden monkeys and other wildlife
- A Hike Mount Bisoke or visit Dian Fossey's research site
- Enjoy warm hospitality from local communities and eco-lodges
- Tapture breathtaking landscapes and rare wildlife moments

Tip: Gorilla permits are limited and in high demand—book early TWO MONTHS PRIOR!

CHILDREN POLICY: Children under 15 years old are not allowed for gorilla trekking

Hike Rwanda's Majestic Volcanoes – Karisimbi & Muhabura 🔌 🌋



If you love adventure, hiking Rwanda's volcanoes in Volcanoes National Park is an unforgettable experience. Two popular choices are:

🚵 Mount Karisimbi (4,507m) – Rwanda's highest peak

- A challenging **2-day hike** for fit trekkers
- Camp overnight near the summit under starry skies
- See rare birds, giant lobelias, and breathtaking alpine vegetation
- From the top: stunning views of the entire Virunga range and even neighboring countries!

🌋 Mount Muhabura (4,127m) – The "Sentinel of the Virungas"

- A **1-day hike**, steep but rewarding
- Panoramic views of Rwanda, Uganda, and the DRC
- At the summit, a beautiful crater lake awaits
- On clear days, you can see all five surrounding volcanoes!

Along the way, hikers enjoy:

Rich biodiversity, from orchids to mountain monkeys

- Crisp mountain air and misty forests
- The peaceful sound of nature, far from busy cities

Tip: Wear layers, bring snacks, and be ready for changing weather. Hiring a porter is highly recommended.
